All of us have a certain amount of mental and emotional tension attached to our singing. Sometimes the voices in our head manifest in some destructive ways and can really hold the voice captive. I will help you let go of these mental blocks and emotional barriers.

I believe that the most difficult battle we face as singers is Confidence. Without it, it s is nearly impossible to be free and let go of our inhibitions. Efficient vocal technique in a positive environment are great ways to finding solutions to breaking inner barriers. Together we will achieve lots!
